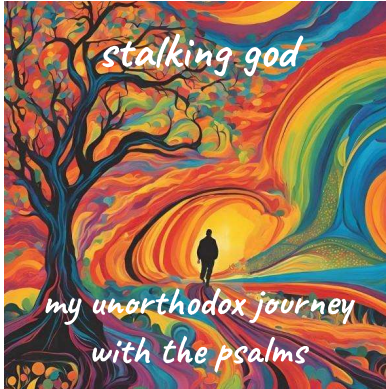

UMCOR CLEANING KIT

Donate items or funds necessary to prepare cleaning kits for people
affected by natural disasters.

ITEMS NEEDED:

One five-gallon round bucket with re-sealable lid
(14.35" h x 12.19" w x 12.19" d)

✓ One 32-64 oz. bottle liquid laundry
detergent

✓ One 6-14 oz. pump spray insect
repellent (pack of 10-20 wipes also
acceptable) Pump spray bottles must
have protective covers

✓ One 16-34 oz. bottle dish soap

✓ One scrub brush (with or without handle)

✓ 36-50 clothespins

✓ One 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or
plastic line)

✓ 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags
(33-45-gallon sizes. Remove from
packaging)

✓ Five scouring pads
(No stainless-steel pads with soap in them.
Remove from packaging)

• No screw lids
• May be used, but must be
free from all residual
product
• Advertisements on the
outside acceptable

✓ One 16-40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate
household cleaner (no spray cleaners)

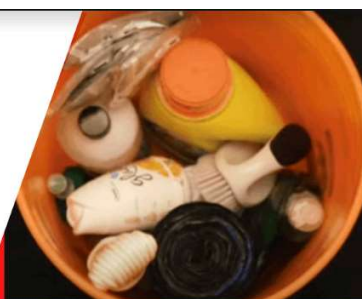
✓ One 4-8 oz. pump spray air freshener
(liquid, not gel)

✓ Five N95 particulate respirator
dust masks (1-3 mm thickness)
(No surgical masks)

✓ Two pairs kitchen gloves
(Durable for multiple uses.
Remove from packaging)

✓ One pair work gloves
(Cotton with leather palm or
all leather)

✓ 18 re-useable cleaning wipes
(No terrycloth, microfiber or
paper towels. Remove from
packaging)
