We have reserved upper tier parking and parking along the curb. Lower tier parking prioritized for exhibit guests.

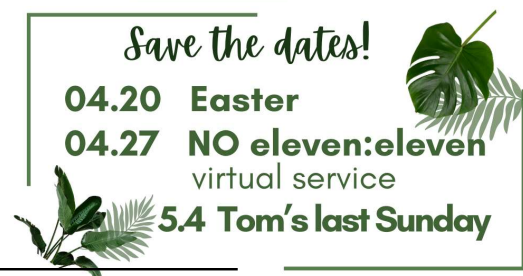
