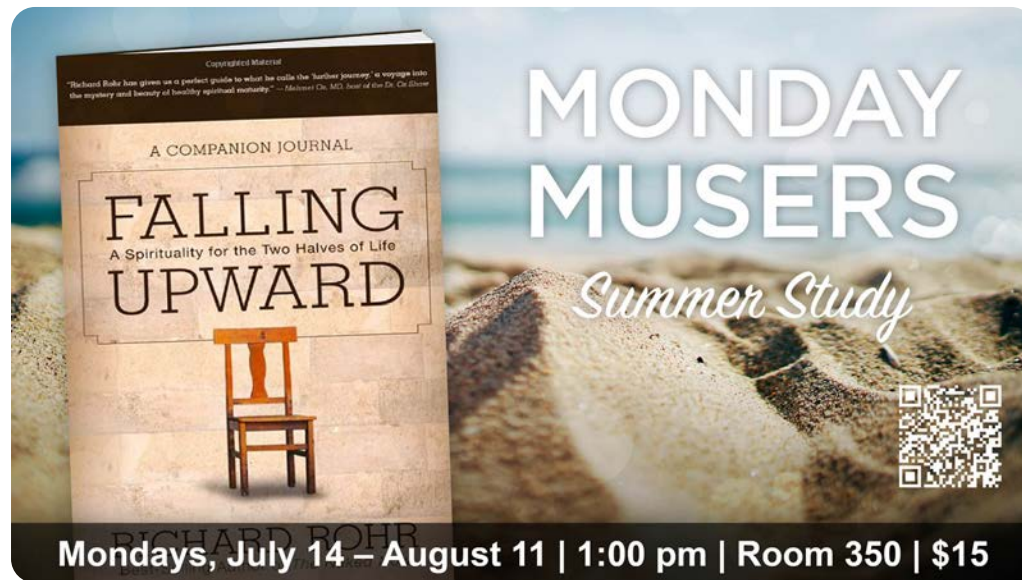

FUMCFW is partnering with Project Transformation Central Texas to provide reading buddy volunteers at McMillan UMC.

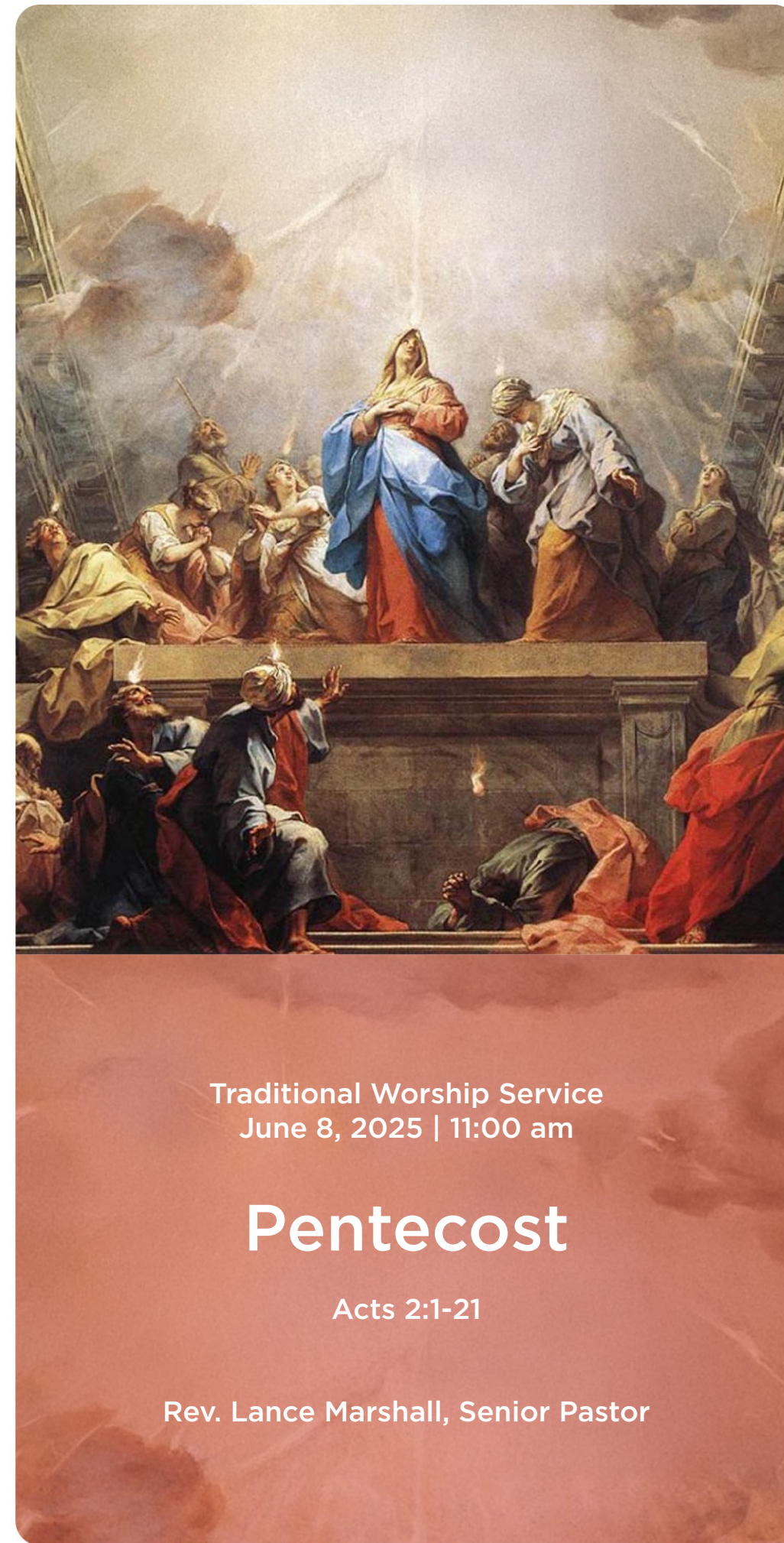
